

II. Tie Breaker Scoring

1. **Weekly Tournaments** – Net scores. Winners for all individual weekly handicapped tournaments that are tied will be determined by a Match of Cards.

A. First tie breaker is back nine total minus your back nine handicap. (for example a 15 handicap gets 7 on the back and 8 on the front strokes off your gross score.)

B. Second tie breaker is front nine total minus front nine handicap.

C. Third tie breaker is best score on the hardest number 1 handicap hole on the back minus handicap.

D. Fourth Tie breaker is best score on the hardest number 1 handicap hole on the front minus handicap

E. If still tied continue alternating back then front hardest holes minus handicap until a winner is found.

2. **Scrambles** – Gross Scores – Match of Cards

A. The same tie break procedure is used for scrambles except that handicaps are NOT used in the totals or in the hole by hole.
