RULES FOR PLAY

- FRONT 9 - BUCK AA, A, B & C WHITE TEE
- BACK 9 - FAWN AA & A BLUE TEE, B & C WHITE TEE
- USGA and LOCAL RULES apply.
- All GPS and LAZER yardage equipment is allowed for play.
- RAKE AND PLACE IN SAND TRAPS
- Any plugged ball (excluding a hazard) lift, clean and drop.

FORMAT

ALL GAMES ARE MATCH PLAY (Each match is worth 1 point)

Holes #1-6: BEST BALL (LIFT, CLEAN, PLACE WITH-IN ONE CLUB LENGTH IN OWN FAIRWAY)

"BEST BALL" play is a match in which each member of the two-man teams plays their own ball. Four balls are in play per hole with each of the four players competing. The team whose player has the lowest score on that hole wins the hole.

Holes #7-#12: SCRAMBLE (LIFT, CLEAN PLACE WITH-IN ONE CLUB LENGTH THROUGH GREEN)

"SCRAMBLE" Both players tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker. 2. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Continue this format until ball is holed.

Holes: #13-#18: SINGLES (LIFT, CLEAN, PLACE WITH-IN ONE CLUB LENGTH IN OWN FAIRWAY)

"SINGLES" is a match in which one player competes against another player. A player wins the match when he is up by more holes than there are holes remaining to play.
